



#### 1.6 Matters Arising

A Board member raised concerns regarding the lack of promotion of long serving staff within schools. It was stated that in some cases long serving staff are overlooked for positions with successful candidates having only been with CMETB for a short period of time and that some staff are disillusioned and choosing not to apply for management roles. A discussion ensued. A number of members who sit on Interviews Boards defended the process and noted that the systems in place focus on ensuring that the most suitable candidates for posts are the ones appointed. It was noted that staffing is an executive function and that the matter could be raised with management and the union. The Chair suggested a presentation to explain the selection process be given at the next meeting.

A member asked if consultation was sought with relevant partners when the review of the Policy on the Code of Conduct for Staff was carried out, which was noted at the November 2023 meeting. DOSD advised that the Code of Conduct is a template provided by the DE in the Code of Practice for Governance of ETBs Circular 0002/2019. Staff policies which may affect terms and conditions are generally negotiated with unions by ETBI or governed by Circular letters.

One of the core objectives for CMETB is dealing with capacity in our schools regarding the increasing enrolments in mainstream and ASD units. Director of Schools advised 8 out of 11 CMETB schools have ASD classes.

A member noted the lack of a Special Education Needs Organiser (SENO) in County Monaghan and also the long travel journeys for some children going to special classes in schools other than their nearest school. DoS agreed there were shortcomings. He acknowledged it is not always possible to place a child in the school nearest their home but confirmed that no student has been left without a school place.

NCSE have been looking at our region regarding a special school for primary level, as the only special school in our area is full. DoS also noted there are some children with a range of complex needs where targeted intervention is needed and in some acute cases not even a special school is suitable.

#### 7.1.1 DFET Report

Director of Further Education and Training gave an informative update on FET activities including details on the number of FET learner completers, which was requested by a member at the November 2023 Board meeting (see *Appendix E*)

DFET was congratulated on meeting, and in some cases exceeding, Solas performance targets for 2023 set out in the Strategic Performance Agreement. The Board acknowledged the achievement of writing two ESOL programs at Levels 1 and 2 and the commencement of work on developing Level 3 and Level 4 programs, which CMETB will be able to share nationally with other ETBs.

A Board member suggested a course in the use of new technologies and Apps for parents of children with SEN would be very welcome. He also asked if a course could be developed to

assist people in the use of new sustainable energy heating systems. DFET advised both could be looked into and will ask a staff member from Adult Education with knowledge of assistive technology to contact him.

The announcement of Reach funding for community groups was also welcomed by Board members.

In relation to road safety a member enquired if Transition Year students have the opportunity to use the Driving Simulator at the SCLP Centre. DFET advised this is possible if the interest and time is available in the TY timetable to travel to Cavan where the simulator is based. Regarding the possibility of having a simulator in County Monaghan, if demand existed a case could be put to Enterprise Ireland to purchase another simulator.

A Board member welcomed the recent announcement by Minister Simon Harris of the expansion of the number of Tertiary Degree courses available in association with FET through the National Tertiary Program, without the need to go through the CAO process.

The members welcomed the Cost-of-living measure to support increased school running costs in 2024. They also look forward to receiving details of the expected book grant for Junior Cycle students. Schools will still have to charge for trips agreed/additional activities.

A member suggested a review of Schools Admissions Policies is required in light of the increasing enrolments which places an extra burden on Boards of Management to restrict enrolment numbers.

DoS confirmed schools increasing enrolment numbers and capacity in schools are logged as red risks on the Schools Risk Register.
