4.2 Finance Update

Ms Amanda Taylor, Finance Officer, briefed the meeting on the Financial Report for April 2025.

The ongoing funding for the School Meals Programme was welcomed. A member asked the DOS if the quality of meals supplied to CMETB students was satisfactory. Director of Schools advised that Principals are working closely with providers and while menus may vary from school to school, the Principals monitor the quality of the food to ensure value for money. He also advised that procedures have been implemented to streamline the delivery of meals at break times to avoid delays. A member also noted that the nutritional value of her son's school meals is stated on the packaging. DOS advised that the IAU are in the process of completing an audit on CMETB School Meals provision, including nutritional value.

A member acknowledged €1.8 million received in funding from the Department of Education and Youth for the Post-Primary Schoolbooks Scheme, which has been extended to Senior Cycle students for the 2025/26 school year. This measure which eliminates book and material costs for families of students from 1st year to Leaving Certificate was welcomed by Board members.

A member reiterated the need to progress the extension at Inver College. He was disappointed with the delay in the planning permission stage. 7.1.1 DFET Report

Dr Linda Pinkster, Director of Further Education and Training, gave an update on FET activities since the last board meeting (see *Appendix D*).

Regarding CMETBs 2025 FET budget allocation, DFET outlined the breakdown under the five funding pots. A member noted the shift in budget emphasis from the focus on apprenticeships last year, which caused an adverse effect on Adult Education with some classes cancelled, to the reverse this year. DFET advised that it is not a desirable position to have funding reallocated from one service area to another which can result in budgetary concerns. This year there is a finite budget, and we know the amount now and will be planning provision accordingly.

The members agreed to lobby ministers to ensure investment in apprenticeships continues, given the shortage of labour in the context of the national housing crisis.

A member inquired about the possibility of upgrading the practical training facility at Cavan Institute. DFET advised that this is being considered.

7.2 Schools

7.2.1 DoS Report



The Director of Schools gave a comprehensive presentation on his Schools Report, which was made available before the meeting (see Appendix E).

He informed the Board of the planned retirement of Mr. Brendán Ó Dufaigh, Principal of Coláiste Oiriall. The DOS praised Mr. Ó Dufaigh's exceptional dedication to Irish-language education in Co. Monaghan and beyond. As the founding Principal of Coláiste Oiriall, his leadership was recognised not only locally but also nationally. DoS acknowledged that Co. Monaghan has the highest percentage of students learning through the medium of Irish, which has been supported through Brendan's commitment over many years to the promotion of the Irish language. The Board members concurred and extended their best wishes to Brendan for his retirement. DoS also informed the Board that Ms. Annette Ní Thuathail was appointed Principal of Coláiste Oiriall, commencing at the start of the new academic year in September 2025. The Board welcomed this announcement and wished Ms Thuathail well in her new role.

DOS confirmed that Ms Belinda Walters had taken up her role as Principal of Monaghan Community Special School. Recruitment for a Deputy Principal has commenced, while recruitment of teachers and SNAs will begin shortly. Eighteen school places have been offered and accepted. Applications for school transport have been submitted to Bus Eireann, who wil consult with NCSE re needs.

A member asked if a survey is carried out on feeder schools to determine the number of special classes required at post primary level in our schools. DoS confirmed that he meets with NCSE annually, who plan two years ahead and include all children with a formal diagnosis.

A member noted the significant challenges for teachers regarding the Senior Cycle reform, including the availability of AI which some students may use to assist with assessments. DoS acknowledged the challenges and hoped that common sense will prevail with many subjects conducting live assessments events e.g. supervised practicals.

Another member raised concerns about student wellbeing in the context of the pressure of having to complete a 40% assessment for every Leaving cert subject.
